DIPLOMA IN LAW

The course is designed to train paralegals and legal assistants interested in building a career in the legal profession. OBJECTIVES

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Division 3 or higher in KCE or EACE and with Credit in English language.

BACHELOR OF LAWS (LLB) UNIVERSITY OF LONDON

The course is a curriculum of the University of London (UK). The successful graduate will be able to understand fully the aspects of law and its procedures, and will be extensively familiar with subject areas of English Law, such as Law of Torts, Trusts & Equity, Criminal and Constitutional Law.

OBJECTIVES

- To provide training for students wishing to practice law locally or internationally as advocates, solicitors, barristers etc.
- To train legal professionals wishing to work in the NGOs, corporate sector, local authorities or in any other sector where training in law is a prerequisite for work.
- To act as a foundation course for those wishing to pursue Master of Laws (LLM).

ENTRY ROUTES

- General Entrance Route
 - Pass in either two subjects at GCE 'A' level and at least three further subjects at GCSE/GCE 'O' level at grade C or above; or
 - Pass in three subjects at GCE 'A' level and one further subject at GCSE/GCE 'O' level at grade C or above; or
 - Passing two subjects at GCE 'A' level and two further subjects at 'AS' level.
- Graduate entry route
 - Holders of first degree by examination awarded by an institution acceptable to the university.
- Holders of ILEX ordinary or Higher Professional Diploma In Law.
- Any other qualification acceptable by the University senate.

INSTITUTE OF LEGAL EXECUTIVES (ILEX) LEVEL 3 DIPLOMA IN LAW & PRACTICE

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

At least four (4) subjects in 'O' level at grade C or above including English language or English literature. At least two of the subjects should be academic.
